POLICY:

An offender may elect to terminate his/her parole status and return to a State Institution during the period of supervision. Any voluntary termination should be executed in writing by the offender, reviewed by the agent, and approved by the Administrative Parole Judge.

PROCEDURE:

1. A request for voluntary termination is used when the offender requests to be revoked without violation. A Parole Violation Review Request is completed per Parole Violation Review policy (705).
2. Return is not effectuated prior to the offender having signed the Voluntary Termination of Parole (710A). There need not be violations of parole for the offender to voluntarily return to the institution.
3. If serious violations of parole have occurred and revocation is contemplated, the offender is not allowed the opportunity to return to the institution voluntarily.
4. The supervising agent investigates and ascertains the reasons for the request for Voluntary Return.
5. If the reason for the request is due to the offender's inability to adapt, alternatives to incarceration are explored and discussed with the offender.
6. An Order for Voluntary Termination (710B) is requested from the Board of Parole at the time the offender signs the Voluntary Return and it is distributed accordingly.
7. Upon execution of the Order for Voluntary Termination, any agent, any sheriff or peace officer of the State of Iowa is authorized and directed to commit the offender whenever and wherever found and hold said offender for return to IMCC by the Correctional Transportation Officer.
