POLICY:

The Director ensures that criteria are developed to determine offender eligibility for TASC services.

PROCEDURE:

1. Staff determines an offender's eligibility for the TASC Program based on the following criteria:
 - A. The offender is involved with the criminal justice system and is supervised by Department staff;
 - B. The offender is under supervision for an aggravated misdemeanor or felony offense;
 - C. The offender resides in a county within the Department's jurisdiction;
 - D. The offender is at least eighteen (18) years of age or has been adjudicated an adult;
 - E. The offender voluntarily agrees to participate in the TASC Program, to include assessment, treatment referral and monitoring;
 - F. At the time of the initial referral, the offender has a minimum of six (6) months remaining on supervision.
 - G. The offender is not involved in substance abuse treatment at the time of the initial referral.
 - H. The offender's lifestyle manifests behavioral characteristics of substance abusers as identified by standard clinical assessment methodologies (e.g. ASAM criteria).
