POLICY:

Staff implement treatment and monitoring standards that allow and promote this population to return and reintegrate into society in a manner consistent with continued growth and reduced risk for recidivism in the community.

PROCEDURE:

1. Staff supervise offenders in this program according to risk level. Risk level is determined according to validated risk assessments as indicated in the Case Management policy (100) and follow Contact Standards (100B).
2. Consideration is given for override to intensive level of supervision in instances where mental health needs are substantial and represent undue risk for destabilization and risk to the community without increased monitoring and support. Supervisory approval is obtained when an override to a higher level of supervision is desired. Level of supervision is reviewed with each case plan update and offenders are returned to the level indicated by risk assessment as soon as is practical without jeopardizing offender stability or unduly increasing risk of re-offending.
