POLICY:

A phase system guides the expectations and requirements of offenders as they progress through the Drug Treatment Court Program. The program has five phases of treatment and one phase of aftercare. Offenders must complete each phase requirement to the satisfaction of the Drug Treatment Court Team before moving on to the next phase. Graduation from the core program occurs after successful completion of Phase Five. A minimum of six (6) months is required in the Aftercare Supervision phase before discharge from probation is considered.

PROCEDURE:

1. Phase advancements are done in accordance with standards and process described in the Drug Treatment Court Handbook (2201B).
