POLICY:

Residential facility staff members do not allow any resident or group of offenders to be in a position of control or authority over the correctional program of another offender or resident.

PROCEDURE:

1. Correctional program requirements are managed by residential facility staff.
2. Staff prohibits any resident or group of residents from exercising control over another resident.
3. Resident's progress in programming is documented.
4. Residential facility staff does not discuss the progress or lack of progress of one (1) resident with another resident.
5. Residential facility staff addresses the offender's correctional program in the privacy of their office or a place that affords privacy and not in an area where their discussion may be overheard by others.
6. If staff discovers that inappropriate control or authority by residents over other residents exists, action is taken to immediately terminate the situation.
