CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND DISPOSITION

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the above-named Parolee's parole is revoked, discharged and Parolee is released from custody all effective on _____ (date).

Since the Parolee's tentative discharge grants credit for time served from the date of admission to DOC custody until the date of expiration of sentence (including any jail time served waiting for a parole revocation hearing), your discharge date does not change unless the Parole Judge decides to take dead time days in this matter.
