

SUPERVISION ENROLLMENT FEES
UPDATED: 7/1/17

Supervision Enrollment Fees were implemented 7/1/97. Amounts of fees throughout the years have changed as follows (based on date of sentence):

- 07/01/97 – 06/30/00 - \$100 Serious Misdemeanor; \$125 Aggravated Misdemeanor; \$150 Felony
- 7/1/00 – 6/30/06 - All offenders required to pay a \$250.00 supervision fee
- 7/1/06 to present - All offenders required to pay a \$300.00 supervision fee

Scenarios

1. **Probation Granted – Not Currently Being Supervised for Other Charges**
A supervision fee is imposed, even if the offender plans to immediately transfer out of state/district.
2. **Probationer Immediately Transfers Out of State**
Upon acceptance by the other state, the supervision fee is waived.
3. **Probationer/Parolee – Transfers to Another District**
When supervision transfers to another district, the balance owing on the current fee is transferred to the receiving district for collection.
4. **OWI Probation – OWI Program – Paroled**
If the probation is revoked to the 321J Program or is discharged while in the OWI Program prior to his/her parole date, then a new supervision fee is assessed at the time of parole for the OWL.
5. **Prison - Parole - Revoked - Work Release – Parole**
A supervision fee is assessed on the first parole. A new supervision fee is also charged for the second parole.
6. **Consecutive Probations**
Multiple probations are ordered consecutively at the same time. A supervision fee is assessed for the first probation. When the first probation ends and the second probation begins, a new supervision fee is assessed for the second probation.
7. **Probation Revoked/Discharged – New Probation Granted on Same Day**
When the first probation was revoked/discharged, this was a termination of supervision. A supervision fee is imposed for the new probation granted. If the offender is on supervision for other charges, no new fee is imposed.
8. **Deferred Judgment – Revoked – Probation Continued with Suspended Sentence**
No new fee is imposed.
9. **Currently on Supervision and Placed on Supervision for New Charge(s)**
No new fee is imposed.
19. **Supervision for Multiple Cases**
When an offender is on supervision and later picks up new charges in original or another district – only one fee is assessed. The district that first supervises the offender assesses the fee.
11. **Released from Prison to Parole**
A supervision fee is imposed unless the offender is being supervised for other charges.

- 12. Probation – Revoked to Prison – Parole**
A supervision fee is assessed for the probation supervision. When paroled, another fee is assessed due to a break in supervision.
- 13. Prison – Work Release – Parole**
A supervision fee is assessed when parole is granted. The amount owed is not deducted from his/her residential banking account until the parole is granted.
- 14. Prison – Sentence Reconsidered – Probation**
A supervision fee for the probation.
- 15. Probation – Revoked to Prison – Sentence Reconsidered – Probation**
The offender is charged a new supervision fee for the second probation because there was a break in supervision. Offender remains liable for any unpaid balance from the first probation.
- 16. Interstate Compact Transfers into Iowa**
Upon acceptance, the offender is assessed a supervision fee.
- 17. Interstate Compact Transfers Out of Iowa to Another State**
Any balance owing is carried for collection.
- 18. Interstate Compact Transfers Out of Iowa to Another State and Later Returns to Iowa**
Upon acceptance, the offender is assessed another supervision fee since there was a break in supervision.
- 19. Paroled Directly from Prison to Another State**
A supervision fee will not be assessed.
- 20. Paroled Directly from Prison to Another State – Returns to Iowa**
A supervision fee for the parole is assessed upon offender's return to Iowa.
- 21. Paroled to Discharge – 30 Days or Less to be Served**
No fee is assessed.
- 22. Parole – Revoked to Prison – Paroled**
A supervision fee is assessed on the second parole because there was a break in supervision.
- 23. Prison released to Special Sentence**
A supervision fee is assessed.
- 24. Probationer Placed in the Residential Facility – Returns to Field Probation**
A single fee is assessed for the probation regardless of field or facility placement.
- 25. On Probation – In Prison for Other Charge(s) – Paroled while Probation is Still Active**
No new supervision fee will be assessed upon parole since the offender was already assessed a fee for probation which is still active.
- 26. Sex Offender Probation or Parole Expires – Immediately moves to Special Sentence**
No new supervision is charged as this is an extension of the original supervision.
