| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Visiting is a privilege and may be denied if circumstances warrant it. The staff on duty will make this decision.</li> <li>2. Visits may be allowed during the following hours: (Each visitor is limited to one hour maximum each day)             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Friday: 1900 - 2100</li> <li>Saturday: 1400 - 1600</li> <li>Sunday: 1400 - 1600</li> </ul> </li> <li>3. All visitors must be approved and placed on the resident's visitor list prior to visiting, except minors under 16 years of age, who must be with an adult.</li> <li>4. Residents are responsible for explaining facility rules regarding the visiting area to their visitors.</li> <li>5. Visiting may be denied if the resident is participating in individual/group counseling or a unit meeting during that time.</li> <li>6. Visitors must be appropriately dressed as determined by staff on duty. Shoes and undergarments are required.</li> <li>7. Visitors with children: Children are expected to act in a manner which does not disrupt others. If the visit becomes disruptive to others, they are asked to leave.</li> <li>8. Visitors between the ages of 16 and 18 must have written permission to visit from their parent/guardian (permission slip are verified by staff). Those under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.</li> <li>9. Profanity is not tolerated during visiting.</li> </ol> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>10. All visitors are subject to search.</li> <li>11. Visitors are NOT ALLOWED to bring personal items into the facility - this includes purses, diaper bags, cell phones, photography equipment, etc.</li> <li>12. No more than three visitors may visit a resident at the same time.</li> <li>13. All visitors must sign in/out and all are required to make staff aware of their presence. Visitors must have a valid ID on their person when visiting residents.</li> <li>14. Visitors who show evidence of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs are not allowed to visit.</li> <li>15. Residents may embrace their visitors upon their entry to and exit from the facility; other displays of affectation are not permitted.</li> <li>16. Residents are not permitted to leave the building to escort visitors to their vehicles.</li> <li>17. No food or beverages of any kind are allowed - you may buy snacks or beverages from the vending machines in the facility.</li> <li>18. Items brought into the facility during visiting hours for the resident are left at the front desk. Items are searched. If approved items are given to the resident after the visit.</li> <li>19. Visitors who fail to follow the rules or those who create serious problems are asked to leave and/or suspended temporarily/indefinitely from the facility. Likewise, residents may receive discipline. Residents are held responsible for the actions of their visitors.</li> </ol> |
